Kerry Chikarovski

Founder and Director, Chikarovski & Associates. Former MP and leader of the New South Wales Liberal Party 1999-2002. Author, Chika (2004)

Kerry Chikarovski is the founder and director of Chikarovski & Associates, a government relations consultancy that helps organisations effect change through better policy communication and influence.

Best known for being the first woman to lead a major political party in New South Wales when she was elected Leader of the NSW Parliamentary Liberal Party (1999-2002). As an MP her responsibilities spanned from consumer affairs to industrial relations, women's affairs to infrastructure. After leaving politics she started Chikarovski & Associates when organisations started to solicit her help to navigate government bureaucracy.

Kerry holds a number of board positions, with her passion for sport evident in roles at NSW Waratahs Rugby Union and NSW Women's Rugby Union, and she works across several not-for-profits including Adopt Change, the Humpty Dumpty Foundation and Our Watch.





Enrique TOPO Rodriguez Impresario, ScrumMuster, Performance Coach

Enrique TOPO Rodriguez is an Argentine-born Australian who made his mark first in Rugby Union.

TOPO represented Argentina, Tahiti and Australia for 42 test-matches (1971-1992), also captained Australia in 1987, his final representative tour of Argentina. TOPO was a member of the 1984 All Conquering Grand Slam Wallabies and the 1986 Bledisloe Cup Winning teams.

TOPO has spent much of his productive life in Sydney as a philanthropist and volunteer to many causes amongst them Fitness and Wellbeing, Spinal & Neck Injuries Prevention, Mental Health Management, and Prostate Cancer. He has been a strong advocate for Affective Disorders (Bipolar, Depression, Melancholia).

These days TOPO is fully dedicated to promoting bilateral relationships and exchanges between Australia and Argentina through the Australian-Argentine Business Council (AABC), his own International Consultancy Business: The ERC Group FZCO, and International Director for The Sydney e-Rotary Club 'Gamarada Eora'.

Since May 2020, TOPO has put his vast network of contacts, time and energy to developing the International Sports Sciences Forum (ISSF).

of rugby, coming from football, through Quixote RC, a club that was founded in the province of Toledo a year earlier.

Javier immediately became very enthusiastic about Quixote RC's and its social rugby projects and the life

philosophy of its founders: Horacio Ferreira and Isabel Pérez, who made him president of the club in 2012. Since then, the club has opened a dozen rugby schools and Quixote RC has become a benchmark of inclusive sport with more than 100 players with intellectual disabilities.

Javier has recently stated "For the last 12 months we have embarked in a driving mission/project to promote Women's Rugby in our region. Furthermore, Spain has an extraordinarily rich tradition in this area with the LEONAS' National Women's Selection which we wish to emulate in the near future".
